A report on the Social Work Students' Forum Activity held on 23.02.2022

Title: Decentralized Planning

Mr. G. Mallikarjun Swamy, Faculty (Rural Development), Abdul Nazir Saab State Institute of Rural Development, Mysuru was the resource person on the topic 'Decentralized Planning' for the Social Work Students' Forum, Development of Students in Social Work, University of Mysore, Mysuru.

He started with the establishment of Panchayat System in India. Panchayati Raj is a form of local government at the village level where each village is responsible for its own activities. The amendment Act of 1992 contains provision for passing the powers and responsibilities to the Panchayat for preparation of plans for economic development and social justice. He discussed about the role of Grama Panchayat in the development of villages in India. What are the roles of Panchayat members and the role of Grama Sabha were also explained. Budget allocation was also discussed. Role and participation of Social Workers in the functions of Panchayat System was also explained. His expertise on the topic helped the students to understand the structure and functions of Panchayat Raj Institutions in India.
