The last play was Lady Macbeth's Agony. Purnima showed the popular scene of lady Macbeth's sleepwalk from Shakespeare's play. It is one of the most appreciated plays of her and it confronts the disorder inherent in it sleepwalking, hallucination and sheer madness.
