

## Spoken English Training - Summary

**Date 20<sup>th</sup> February, 2023 to 7<sup>th</sup> March, 2023**

**Description:-** University Career Hub [UCH] organised a Spoken English Training Program for 3<sup>rd</sup> Semester Students of Department of Studies in Social Work, **University of Mysore, Manasagangothri**, for a total of 34 students. The classes are scheduled between 4.00 p.m. and 5.30 p.m. on Mondays, Tuesdays and Wednesdays and between 2.30pm and 5.30 pm on Saturdays for 15 hours from 20<sup>th</sup> Feb to 4<sup>th</sup> March, 2023.

**Day1:- 20<sup>th</sup> February, 2023**

Smt. Hamsaveni L, Coordinator, UCH, briefed the students about the importance of the training program and encouraged the students to make use of the opportunity that was provided to them and also appraised them to speak in English during the sessions so that they could speak confidently by the end of the training program. Smt. Jyothi H P, Chairman, Department of Studies in Social Work, Manasagangothri, wished the students and told them to improve their communication skills. Smt. Jayashree M J, English Consultant, UCH, addressed the students as to how this training program could help them in their future prospects. The classes took a shape with the students actively participating in the usage of vowels and consonants and Sentence formation, which was explained with examples by the subject expert. Students were assessed in the class room. The sessions were very interactive. UCH Staff also actively participated in the day's training.

**A total of 23 students attended the session.**

**Day2:- 21<sup>st</sup> February, 2023**

On this date, the basic concepts of Plurals and its usage was explained. Also students were briefed about uses of This, That, These etc.... Students were assessed in the class room.

**A total of 28 students attended the session.**

**Day3:- 22<sup>nd</sup> February, 2023**

Parts of speech and its uses were explained with examples. It was a very interactive session. Students listed out few examples. Students were given Assignments.

**A total of 28 students attended the session.**

**Day4:- 25<sup>th</sup> February, 2023**

Genders and nouns were explained with a lot of examples in today's session. Students were given Assignments. A lot of examples were given.

**A total of 07 students attended the session.**

**Day5:- 27<sup>th</sup> February, 2023**

Tenses were explained in today's session. Students were asked to frame sentences using the various tenses.

**A total of 31 students attended the session.**

**Day6:- 1<sup>st</sup> March, 2023**

Sentences with commonly made errors were explained with examples in today's session. Students were asked to reframe the sentences without committing any errors.

**A total of 24 students attended the session.**

**Day7:- 4<sup>th</sup> March, 2023**

Reading skills of students were monitored and corrected. Few were able to read fluently. By the end of the session all the students present were able to read fluently.

**A total of 11 students attended the session.**

**Day8:- 7<sup>th</sup> March, 2023**

Students were asked to frame a few sentences of their choice about any topic. Students were asked to read the same. Writing skills of each student was monitored and corrected. By the end of the session all the students present were able to write and read fluently.

**A total of 16 students attended the session.**

At the end of the program the students learnt the basic concepts of English and were able to speak confidently.
