Report of the 23rd Refresher Course in English

The 23rd Refresher Course in English was conducted by the UGC-Human Resource Development Centre, University of Mysore from 02-11-2022 to 15-11-2022. The theme of the Refresher Course was “Literature and Culture: Texts and Contexts”.
