University of Mysore, Centre for Gandhi Studies, Manasagangotri, Mysore in collaborated with Maitri Balaga and Angala Sahitya Balaga, Mysore organized a seminar on "Contemporary Social Anxieties and Youth" at Gandhi Bhavan premises, Manasagangotri on Tuesday: 31-10-2023 at 02:30 PM.

H.S. Anupama, author spoke at the beginning of the conversation. Said, there are many confusions among the youth, it was believed that if education comes, everything will change. But she expressed regret that the current situation has not happened. There is 85 percent literacy in the country. But even today those who do not go to school are looked down upon. Instead of developing knowledge, the upper-lower caste system is becoming more violent. Even the highly educated are rife with inequality. Human values should be more relevant, she said.

Qualitative research should be conducted at the university level. Research students face several problems. India needs to prove its youth power globally. European countries have the highest number of elderly people. There are 45 crore youth in India between 18 to 25 years. This is equal to the population of the United States. Is this amount of youth power well spent? She asked the audience to answer. There are more than 100 universities in the country. The number will increase if deemed universities are also included. Between 2003 and 2013, 45,561 Ph.D graduates, are they got the jobs? Why is the quality of humanities research papers declining? Another question was raised that what is the use if you do not get a job even after studying for so many years?

Identity has blinded the world. We have descended into the degeneracy of the entanglements of name, caste, religion, ideology and party. Manipur is an example of what can happen when identity is overdone. It is a tragedy that thousands of men have been gang-raped by naked girls in Manipur. He said that it is very regrettable that the women of Maitteyi community have been encouraged to commit violence.

Author Krishnamurthy Chamaram said that problems have always existed. Good works have been done even in times of lack of comfort. He said that the youth should think about the problems from a personal basis and think about what they should do to solve those problems.

Research student Shabana said that Young community is running after a different life. Division is being done on the basis of caste and religion. He said that everything should be removed from the personal base including the name.

Director of Gandhi Bhavan, Prof. S. Speaking, Narendrakumar said that in this land of India where great people like Buddha, Basavanna, Gandhi, Ambedkar etc. were

born, the mass of people should get rid of the shackles of social evils such as upperlower, poor-educated, caste and class. On this occasion, he opined that the youth should make good use of their time and develop humanity and environmental awareness along with education.

Gandhi Bhavan faculty members, research scholars of Gandhi Bhavan and of various departments, students and members of Maitri Balaga and Angal Sahitya Balaga participated in the conversation.
