**Proceedings of the BOS (CB) Meeting held on 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> June 2024**

As per the University direction BOS meeting was convened on **06-06-2024** to discuss and revise the first two semester's syllabus for UG as per SEP structure and also to revise PG syllabus of the first two semesters of both Economics and Cooperative Management. The Board has unanimously resolved, approved and to accept the following decisions:

Cooperatives in Developed Countries</b> The Board decided to reduce the content as the credit has been reduced from 6 to 5.The revised syllabus is submitted to the University for its approval

03	Revising MA syllabus for Economics and Cooperation	The Board unanimously decided to revise the existing <b>CBCS 2021 revised</b> syllabus only for first two semesters and also to reduce the number of units to 5 units in each paper(both HC and SC) and to reduce the number of units to 4 in OE papers.
04	Modification of question paper pattern	The Board decided to make no changes in the question paper pattern for UG. But for MA in Economics and Cooperation the Board unanimously approved changed question paper pattern which is Part I 5x5 =25 marks Part II 3x10=30 marks Part III 1x15=15 Total 70 marks pattern
05	Approval of the panel of Examiners	The revised Panel of Examiners for 2024-25 is submitted to the University for approval.
