

Memorandum of Understanding

The Memorandum of Understanding is made on 15th July, 2024

The HCG Cancer Care Centre, Bengaluru, Karnataka- 560027 now being represented by its Founder and Executive Chairman (here in after referred to as the HCG Cancer Care Centre, Bangalore) of the two part:

The University of Mysore, Mysuru and HCG Cancer Care Centre, Bangalore (here in after referred to singularly as the Participant and collectively as the Participants.

- a. Whereas the Department of Studies in Genetics and Genomics of University of Mysore intends to collaborate with HCG as the above named Institution recognises that research partner and academic collaboration could be of mutual benefit and would strengthen Genomic Research and Development of cancer cells.
- b. Whereas HCG has agreed to collaborate with the University of Mysore by engaging in their schemes through the course, internship/incubation for M.Sc Genetics/PG Diploma in Personalised Genomic Medical students for the purpose of Cancer Cell Genomic research.

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL COVENANTS HEREIN SET FORTH, THE PARTIES AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

1.SCOPE

The parties agree to collaborate in the following areas:-

1.1 Knowledge Partnership

The Postgraduate Diploma in Personalised Genomic Medicine (PGDPGM) students after successful completion of first semester shall undergo detailed Internship at HCG/Institution for a period of sixteen (16) weeks by utilising the Clinical facilities available at HCG.

1.2 Students Internship for M.Sc Genetics

The students after successful completion of three semesters in University of Mysore can take up Joint research projects in association with HCG for a period of sixteen (16) weeks in fourth semester of the programme.

1.3 Development of research protocol

Foster and strengthen research partnership for the advancement of knowledge in the field of cancer genetics and cancer care. Collaborative research programs in specific fields of interest HCG and University of Mysore shall jointly identify specific fields to conduct collaborative research programs of mutual interest and benefit both the parties.

1.4 Need based academic collaboration

Submission of joint project proposals may be jointly submitted to DBT,CSIR, DST, and ICMR or any other funding agencies for carrying out further studies of selected projects or any other research areas of mutual interest and benefit.

2. OBLIGATIONS:

Both the parties acknowledge the mutual alignment of their vision, mission and values. Both the parties commit themselves to jointly accomplish the goals of research and development for the purpose of better cancer patient care and novel identification of genome mutations causing cancer.

2.1 Publication:

- i. The parties shall consult each other for any publication in respect of research work. These publications (papers, reports etc.) shall be in the names of actual research workers wherein it will be duly acknowledged that the work has been carried out under the collaborative research program of HCG and University of Mysore. As a part of collaboration, the outcomes of the research under this MoU shall be developed as joint publication of both the parties.
- ii. Any publication, document and/or paper arising out of joint work conducted by the participants pursuant to this MoU will be jointly owned by both the parties. The use of the name, logo and/or official emblem of the parties on any publication, document and/or paper will require prior written permission of both the parties. It may however be ensured that the official emblem and logo are not misused by either party.
- iii. The Data if any, being shared for the purpose of this MOU shall be in ammonized or encrypted format and shall not have integration with software or servers of either party without prior written consent. The data shared shall not be in breach of any applicable laws.

2.2 Financial Support:

This MOU throughout the term shall have not have any financial implications to both the parties. For long term viability and sustainability of research and development both parties agree to explore and identify respective funding opportunities if any which shall be discussed and reduced to writing.

2.3 Focal Person(s):

The Chairperson, DoS in Genetics and Genomics, University of Mysore and the Executive Chairman of HCG Bangalore are the designated nodal persons to provide all the necessary support to the tasks whose duties include supporting the activities for the smooth and successful implementation under this MoU.

3. LANGUAGE

All written correspondence and the activities relating to the tasks shall be in the English language.

4. FORCE MAJEURE

The parties shall not be liable for any failure to perform its obligation where such a failure is a result of Acts of God, which are here defined as force majeure.

5. DURATION AND TERMINATION

The MoU shall come into effect on the date of signature by the parties and shall remain in force for a period of two (02) years, unless otherwise terminated with 30 (thirty) days prior written notice without cause to the other. The agreed period may be extended by mutual consent of both parties.

6. DISPUTE RESOLUTION

Both the parties agree that in the event of any dispute or any difference between both parties arising out of this MOU or in the interpretation of the any of the provisions thereof, they shall endeavour to meet in an effort to resolve such dispute by discussion within 30 (thirty) days of such dispute failing any amicable resolution then the parties in dispute shall refer the unresolved dispute to a sole arbitrator appointed by mutual consent of both the parties and the arbitration shall governed by the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 and any other amendments thereafter. The Arbitration proceedings shall be held at Mysore or through virtual mode and language of the arbitration shall be in English. The Arbitration award shall be final and binding on the parties.
