
















World Wetlands Day is celebrated each year on 2 February to raise awareness about wetlands. Wetlands and Human Wellbeing spotlights how interconnected wetlands and human life are, with people drawing sustenance, inspiration and resilience from these productive ecosystems. Importantly, it underscores how all aspects of human wellbeing are tied to the health of the world's wetlands. Wetland flora is vital to both adaptation and mitigation. Mangrove forests and seagrass meadows protect shorelines from storm surges and sea level rise. Mangroves are also superheroes at capturing and storing carbon. In fact, it is estimated that they store four times more carbon than other tropical forests. Peatlands cover only about 3% of our planet's land but store approximately twice the amount of carbon than all the world's forests combined. Conversely, the loss and degradation of wetlands exacerbates the climate crisis by releasing greenhouse gases and leaving ecosystems and the people dependent on them, more vulnerable to the effects of climate change.
