## **Report on “The Constitution of India and Its Challenges”**

Prof. Maruthi T. R., a respected Professor of Law and Chairman at the University of Mysore, delivered a comprehensive lecture on the Constitution of India, emphasizing its foundational role in the governance of the nation. He began by explaining that the Constitution serves as the fundamental political code, outlining the structure, procedures, powers, and duties of government institutions. It also establishes the fundamental rights of citizens, directive principles for state policy, and the duties expected from the citizens of India. Adopted by the Constituent Assembly on November 26, 1949, and effective from January 26, 1950, the Constitution was shaped significantly by the Government of India Act, 1935.

In his discussion, Prof. Maruthi highlighted various conflicts that the Constitution attempts to address, such as the balance between man and nature, and between equality and fairness. He pointed out that issues of equity, reciprocity, and community are vital to maintaining social harmony, especially in a country with deep socio-economic divides. He also touched on the influence of global forces, like the World Trade Organization (WTO) and the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), and how these impact India's constitutional values and policies.


The Preamble of the Constitution was emphasized as a crucial element, encapsulating the philosophy, objectives, and core values of the nation. It reflects the intentions of the framers of the Constitution, offering a glimpse into the source of the Constitution, the nature of the Indian state, and the objectives it seeks to achieve. Prof. Maruthi discussed the key objectives laid out in the Constitution, including social, economic, and political justice, as well as the principles of equality, liberty, and fraternity.

Fundamental rights, as outlined in Chapter 3 of the Constitution, were a significant focus of the lecture. These rights, ranging from the right to equality to the right to constitutional remedies, are crucial for safeguarding individual freedoms and ensuring justice in the country. Prof. Maruthi also reviewed landmark Supreme Court judgments that have shaped the interpretation of the Constitution over the years, including cases like *Kesavananda Bharati* (1973), *Minerva Mills* (1980), and *Vishaka v. State of Rajasthan* (1997).

Prof. Maruthi addressed the ongoing challenges to the Constitution, such as issues related to constitutional morality, social justice, federalism, and human rights, particularly concerning women, children, and marginalized communities. He discussed the tensions between constitutional supremacy and parliamentary supremacy, as well as the enduring effects of colonial legacies. These challenges, he argued, threaten the effectiveness and integrity of the Constitution in contemporary India.

In conclusion, Prof. Maruthi urged the audience to recognize their obligations towards the Constitution, emphasizing the need to actively engage in its implementation. By upholding the Constitution's values and addressing the challenges it faces, citizens can ensure that it continues to serve as a robust framework for justice and governance in India.
