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

Special Lecture by Prof. Ananta Kumar Giri
Madras Institute of Development Studies, Chennai.

Prof. Ananta Kumar Giri, delivered a Special Lecture on 'Gandhi and Wittgenstein' on 21st September 2024 at the Department of Studies in Philosophy, University of Mysore, He quote that Mahatma Gandhi and Ludwig Wittgenstein were great thinkers and seekers of our times. We can learn a lot by Waking and Meditating with Gandhi and Wittgenstein together. Both Wittgenstein and Gandhi took part in the First World War, Gandhi Gathering soldiers for the British Army and Wittgenstein giving his support to the Austro-Hungarian forces. But despite this, both of them were Votaries of Peace and Challenged us to Understand the Crisis of Modern Civilization and to go beyond it in terms of engagement with Philosophy, both of them cultivated a non-Philosophical approach to Philosophy and life challenging us to understand the limits of specialized philosophy or professional philosophy. Both Wittgenstein and Gandhi were Contemporaries but nether Gandhi wrote anything about Wittgenstein, nor did Wittgenstein write anything about Gandhi. However both were lovers of philosophy, language and education .
