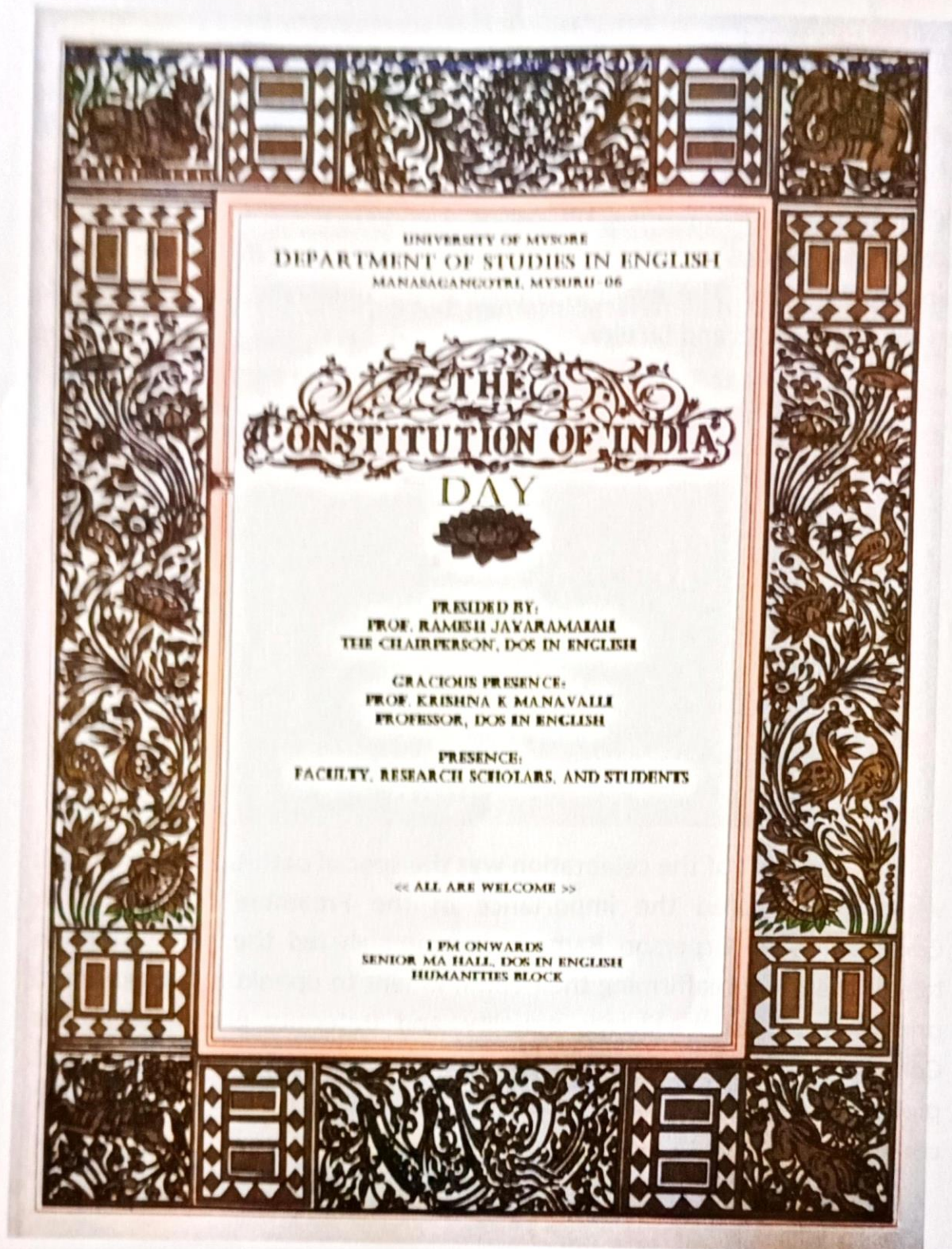


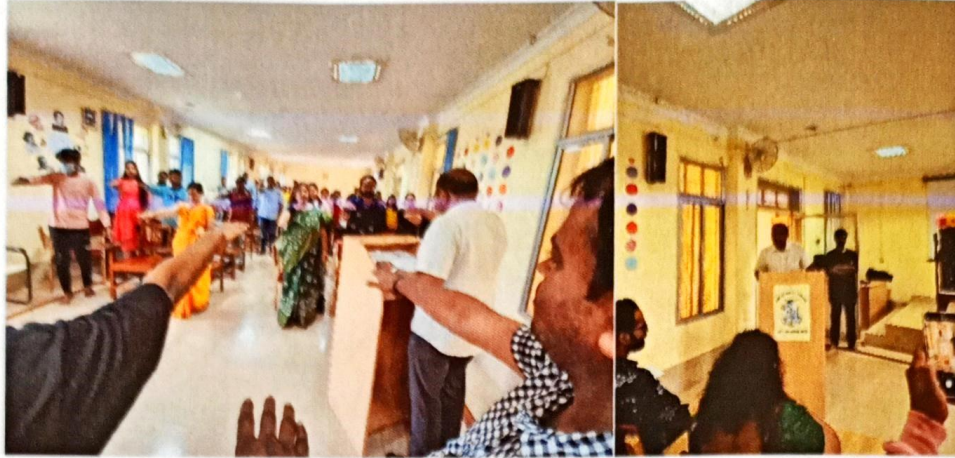
CONSTITUTION DAY CELEBRATION-2023
