

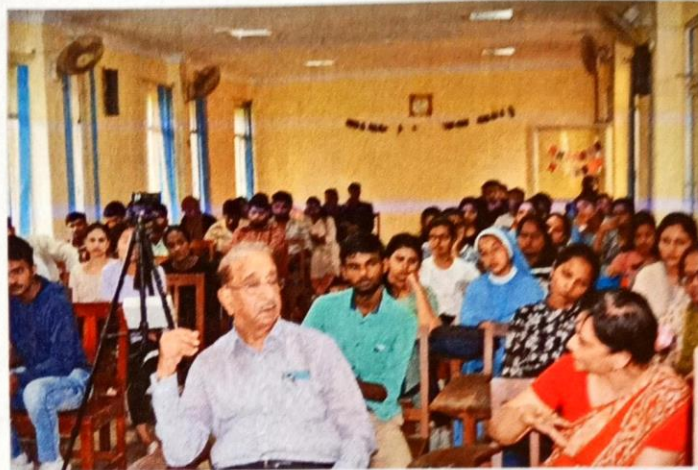
CONSTITUTION DAY CELEBRATION IN COLLABORATION WITH DEPARTMENT OF

20TH JANUARY, 2024


